Candidates may also represent a broad range of under-served and equity-seeking groups such as, but not limited to: Indigenous Peoples, faith-based groups, LGBTQ+, newcomers, new Canadians, persons living in poverty, people of diverse ethnic or cultural origin, seniors, women, and youth.

Committee members make recommendations to Council on a range of initiatives to make Victoria a more accessible and inclusive community and will serve for up to a one-year term as to be determined upon completion of the City's Governance Review.
