The County of Wellington is seeking three community members to join the Accessibility Advisory Committee. The community members must be actively involved with organizations for people with disabilities, be a caregiver for people with disabilities, or a person living with a disability.

The Accessibility Advisory Committee meets four times per year and will be compensated for mileage and per diem.

The main purpose and of the Accessibility Advisory Committee is to:

- Advise Wellington County Council on the preparation, implementation and effectiveness of its annual accessibility plan.
- Advise Wellington County Council on other accessibility related issues within the County.

Applicants must reside in the County of Wellington and be over 18 years of age. As per the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, a majority of the committee members will include people with disabilities.
